# **INSTRUCTION for receipt, storing and maintenance of wooden components.**

## **Receipt of Goods**

When unloading staircases with wooden treads the following has to be observed:

Treads and other components of wood must under no circumstance be exposed to moisture. This means that these components must be stored in heated storerooms, never in unheated storerooms.

## **Cleaning**

When cleaning wooden treads be economical with water and strong detergents. After cleaning the treads must be wiped dry very carefully. This applies to both oiled and lacquered treads.

## **Maintenance**

### **Oiled treads**

In order to preserve the finish from normal wear treads have to be surface treated a couple of times every year. This is called for when the surface looks dry and has lost its lustre. Clean and treat with oil of suitable quality.

### **Lacquered Treads**

In order to preserve the finish from normal wear lacquered treads should be treated once a year. In staircases where extreme wear is experienced this treatment should be carried out 2 to 3 times every year. Clean the treads, let dry and coat with transparent hardening lacquer using a brush.
